Visual Differences

The silver image area of the SDP-FRS175 plates has a slight gold tone. This is a result of the change to the hydrophilic polymer. This is not a defect and does not affect print performance.

GraphLine will begin to transition inventory to the new SDP-FRS starting this summer as the FRm-175 inventory is depleted. Pricing for the SDP-FRS175 remains the same as the SDP-FRm175.
